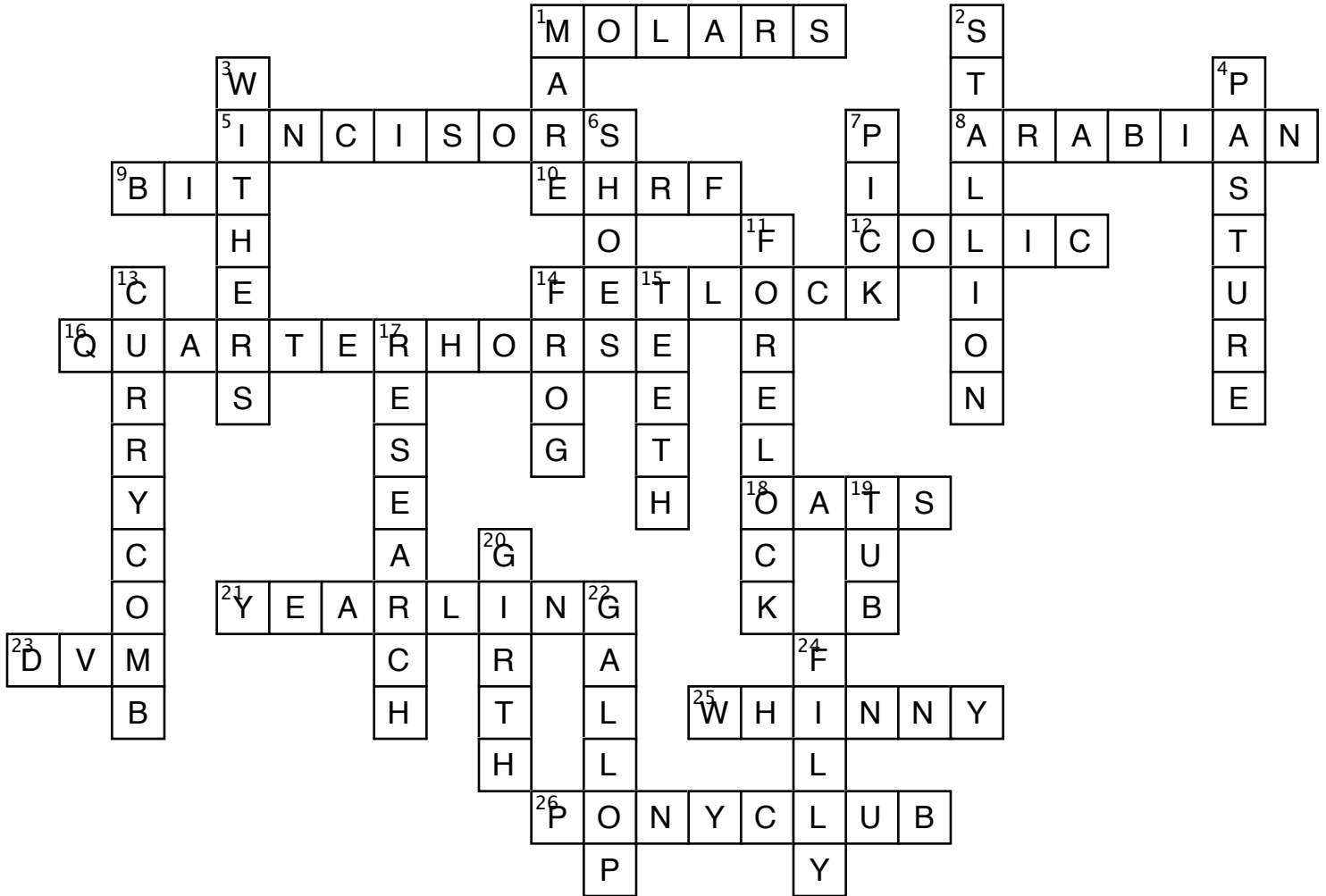


Horse Play!
